

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

SLOVAK NUCLEAR FORUM

("SJF")

AND

KOREA NUCLEAR ASSOCIATION FOR

INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

("KNA")

ON

COOPERATION IN NUCLEAR ENERGY

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This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the “**MOU**”) is hereby made and entered into on the **28th of January, 2019** by and between the “Slovak Nuclear Forum” (hereinafter referred to as “**SJF**”) of the Slovak Republic, and the “Korea Nuclear Association for International Cooperation” (hereinafter referred to as “**KNA**”) of the Republic of Korea. The SJF and KNA are hereinafter jointly referred to as the “**Parties**”;

CONSIDERING that the SJF is a non-governmental organization aimed at promoting the peaceful use of nuclear energy, whose members promote the peaceful utilization of nuclear energy in the Slovak Republic;

WHEREAS the KNA is a non-profit organization supported by the Korean government to represent the Korean nuclear industry for international cooperation and overseas communication;

STRESSING the importance of cooperation and the exchanging of information in the field of nuclear energy development, as well as the promotion of peaceful nuclear energy use,

HAVE AGREED TO AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 3: NON-BINDING OBLIGATIONS

ARTICLE 1: PURPOSE

The purpose of this MOU is to establish, support, develop and facilitate cooperation between experts of nuclear power industries of the Slovak Republic and the Republic of Korea. Cooperation between the Parties is intended to bolster the capability of the nuclear power industry, leading to the peaceful utilization of nuclear energy, economic prosperity, and environmental sustainability.

This MOU is intended to support cooperation between nuclear industry-related personnel and bodies of the Slovak Republic and the Republic of Korea, in order to promote the nuclear energy industry, and thus advocate:

- A. The peaceful utilization of nuclear energy; and
- B. Economic prosperity and environmental awareness on a bilateral and global scale.

ARTICLE 2: SCOPE OF COOPERATION

In accordance with the purpose of the MOU, the Parties jointly decide to cooperate in the following areas, including but not limited to:

- A. Joint organization of information exchange meetings, workshops and/or seminars, alternating between the Slovak Republic and the Republic of Korea, in connection with the common interest of both Parties;
- B. Information exchange between experts in the area of nuclear power industry to enhance the cooperation between both Parties;
- C. Information sharing in relation to this MOU to ensure efficient cooperation between the Parties, including providing feedback to enhance cooperation; and
- D. Other matters according to the mutual consent of both Parties.

ARTICLE 3: NON-BINDING OBLIGATIONS

This MOU serves to keep record of the Parties' understanding and consolidate the Parties' preliminary intention, with respect to the proposed arrangement of this MOU under **Article 1 (PURPOSE)**, but shall not legally bind any obligations on the Parties hereto, except for **Article 5 (CONFIDENTIALITY)** of this MOU.

ARTICLE 4: FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

Unless mutually agreed otherwise, each Party will bear its own expenses rising from any activity held between the Parties under this MOU.

ARTICLE 5: CONFIDENTIALITY

The Parties understand the communication covered by this MOU does not include any confidential data and / or information. If the communication includes any confidential data and / or information, the Parties will adopt the provision to its protection / preservation. Such provision will remain in force beyond the termination or expiration of this MOU for any reason(s).

ARTICLE 6: ENTRY INTO EFFECT, DURATION, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT

6.1) This MOU will enter into effect upon the date of signing by the Parties.

6.2) The valid period of this MOU is for **two years** from the effective date, and shall automatically be renewed for **another two years** unless the terminating Party notifies the other Party 2 months prior to the date of expiration in writing.

6.3) This MOU may be amended at the request of either Party, by mutual written consent.

6.4) Upon the termination or expiry of this MOU, with the exception of that which has been agreed upon in Article 5(CONFIDENTIALITY), neither Party shall have any claim against the other Party for any cost and/or compensation whatsoever.

ARTICLE 7: COMMUNICATION

All correspondence regarding the activities required and related to this MOU shall be communicated through the channels below, unless mutual written consent has been made otherwise.

8.1) All correspondence under this MOU shall be in English.

8.2) When this MOU is entered into force and in time of its force, neither Party shall assign or transfer any of its rights, interests, and obligations hereunder to any third Party without prior written consent or approval of the other Party.

8.3) This MOU does not constitute any exclusivity between the Parties related to the optionally established contacts with other entities on the communication / cooperation in the field of peaceful use of nuclear energy and / or to the general activities of both Parties.

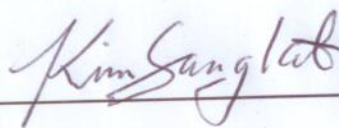
